The region offers year-round play on challenging and well-maintained courses for golfers of all skill levels. Tiger Point Golf & Country Club, The Club at Hidden Creek, and The Moors regularly hold pro tournaments – most notably the Blue Angel Classic PGA Champions Tour Event – letting golfers follow in the footsteps of PGA greats. The Club at Hidden Creek carries a 4.5-star Golf Digest ranking, which is no surprise given the Club's fast, meticulously maintained greens and scenic terrain.

Tiger Point East and The Moors boast Scottish links-style designs honoring the birthplace of golf, and Tiger Point's championship West Course features a daunting layout for major tournament play.

Northwest of Navarre Beach in Pace, Stonebrook Golf Club's narrow fairways and strategically placed hazards make for a challenging test of golf, while in nearby Milton, Tanglewood Golf & Country Club offers 18 fun and forgiving holes.
